Volunteer Opportunities

Golf Cart Greeters: (8 Needed)

These are the first faces guests see when they arrive. From 5:30pm to 7:00 pm they greet guests and welcome them to the event. They have guests fill out the registration cards as they ride the golf carts along the pathway to inside the venue. This makes for a speedy and quick check in process. No waiting in long lines. These volunteers need to be upbeat and cheery.

Path Greeters: (8 Needed)

5:30pm to 7:00 pm, they smile and wave as guests go by. We have volunteers outside the entrance to greet guests as they walk in. Encourage guests to go to registration, have a great time, and visit the red carpet with backdrop to have their photo taken. Then after the event concludes, these volunteers thank the guests for coming (9:30pm – 10:30pm).



Registration and Check-Out: (12 Needed)

5:30pm to 10:30pm, these volunteers must be willing to stay the entire time. These volunteers must be able to deliver excellent customer service and be comfortable working with computers.

Back-Up Support for Registration and Check-Out: (6 Needed)

5:30pm to 10:30pm, these volunteers will be on the move and must wear comfortable shoes. These volunteers will be handing out program books and/or envelopes to the guests as they check in. Also, they will be assisting with check out once the event is over. Volunteers must be willing to stay the entire time.

Catering Volunteers/Table Bussers: (40 Needed)

5:30pm to 9:30pm, these volunteers help us clear plates and keep the venue tidy. We appreciate this so much. Also, please help pick up any trash that may be found on the floor near the food buffet line and seating area.

Silent Auction Volunteers: (20 Needed)

5:30pm to 10:30pm, these volunteers will work around the silent auction area and answer questions about the silent auction items, encourage guests to bid on their mobile phones and touch pads. In this role, you are helping us raise money for the St. Jude Kids. This is a great role for those of you who are great sales people!
