St. Jude Math-A-Thon is a weeklong service learning program that helps students nationwide refine their academic skills. As they solve math problems, students gather donations to support the kids battling cancer and other life-threatening diseases at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.®



Who Am I Helping?

In April 2017, Harper was found to suffer from a rare type of liver cancer called undifferentiated embryonal sarcoma. At St. Jude, she underwent surgery to remove the tumor, followed by chemotherapy and photon radiation therapy.

Treatments invented at St. Jude have helped push the overall childhood cancer survival rate from 20 percent to 80 percent since it opened 50 years ago. "I cannot imagine our world without St. Jude in it," Harper's mom said. "We're forever grateful for everything they've done for us. When we come for appointments, Harper says it feels like home."
