Kids should be aware that adults in vehicles can't see them on their riding toy. • Parents should make sure kids only ride in safe places like on sidewalks or in recreation areas. Day Three Always be careful near driveways.

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Always be careful near driveways.

- Children should always be alert to see if cars are pulling in or out of a driveway.
- Kids should be careful not to ride into other people's driveways and should stay close to home.
- Parked cars in driveways can suddenly move and their doors can suddenly open, so children need to be careful around them.
