Hannah's Story

HANNAH

age 12 | bone cancer

Four years ago, a horrific fire sent Hannah to a burn unit for 55 days. Nearly 20 percent of her body was burned, requiring excruciating treatments and skin grafts to her arm and back. Finally, life seemed to be returning to normal. But then Hannah discovered a knot in her upper left leg and groin area. Tests showed Hannah had a type of cancer called Ewing sarcoma. At St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, Hannah's treatment included chemotherapy and radiation therapy. Despite everything she's been through, Hannah is thriving. She likes to ride her scooter and help out in the yard. When she grows up, Hannah wants to be a nurse at St. Jude. She's now done with treatment and visits St. Jude for regular checkups.

St. Jude Key Messaging

- Families never receive a bill from St. Jude for treatment, travel, housing or food because all a family should worry about is helping their child live.
- Treatments invented at St. Jude have helped push the overall childhood cancer survival rate from 20% to more than 80% since it opened more than 50 years ago.
- St. Jude is working to drive the overall survival rate for childhood cancer to 90%, and **we won't stop until no child dies from cancer**.
- St. Jude freely shares the discoveries we make, and every child saved at St. Jude means doctors and scientists worldwide can use that knowledge to save thousands more children.

St. Jude Quick Facts

- St. Jude is where doctors send their toughest cases because St. Jude has the world's best survival rates for some of the most aggressive childhood cancers.
- St. Jude is the only National Cancer Institute-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center devoted solely to children.
- St. Jude has helped increase the survival rates for acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) from 4% before opening in 1962 to 94% today.
- St. Jude researchers and doctors have research and treatment programs for children with pediatric HIV and AIDS, as well as using new drugs and therapies to fight related infections.

Gifts That Give

When hosting your Auction for Hope event, Gifts that Give donations will be used to provide breakthrough research, treatment and cures.

\$1,000	Help cover about two-thirds of the cost of one day of chemotherapy. Help provide parent necessities for 20 patient families.
\$2,500	Help cover the cost of five days of oxygen for a St. Jude patient. Help provide an ultrasound study.
\$3,500	Help cover average cost of one outpatient visit. Help Child Life host the annual Teen Formal.
\$5,000	Help cover the cost of the daily room rate of the ICU. Help provide 10 platelet transfusions.
\$7,500	Help provide nearly two months of Child Life Specialist services. Help provide new materials for the Linda R. Hajar Family Resource Center.
\$10,000	Help provide grocery gift cards for two years for one St. Jude family. Help provide one CT scan for a St. Jude patient.

The cost of each item or service is an approximation, and will vary based on actual costs incurred and individual patient needs.
