	 Access to electronic device (such as PC, tablet, phone, etc.) to correspond with other E-Council members
	Ability to successfully complete the E-Council membership application
Training:	 Complete level I adviser training including HIPAA and confidentiality basics, overview of FCC, and role description
	Understand and accept:

	Criteria for removal from E-Council
Competencies:	Work effectively with others and without direct supervision
