Objective:	Serves in a leadership position and works directly with the Parent Mentor Coordinator, PAIR mentors and appropriate St. Jude staff.	
Hours:	Meeting times and office hours vary weekly.	
Qualifications:	<ul> <li>Parent of a child who has been a patient at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Patient is at least one year off active "on-therapy" treatment</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Previous experience as a PAIR Mentor is required.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Commitment of at least 1 year with consecutive years of service per the Parent Mentor Coordinator and Director of Volunteer Services' discretion.</li> </ul>	
Training:	Successful completion of Volunteer Services orientation and other on- boarding activities as requested, annual volunteer and FCC training, PAIR Mentor training and any other secondary training as determined by the Parent Mentor Coordinator.	
Competencies:	<ul> <li>Exceptional verbal, written, interpersonal and customer service skills required.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Ability to relate to diverse age and demographic backgrounds. Sound understanding of concepts of Family Centered Care.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Demonstrates organizational, problem solving and negotiation skills, emotional maturity and the ability to partner with other parents and staff in a professional way.</li> </ul>	
	• Capable of working with a diverse customer population, expressing global empathy and adapting to unique situations.	
	<ul> <li>Demonstrates an independent work initiative.</li> </ul>	
	• Serves as a parent volunteer in the family centered care program	
Responsibilities:	<ul> <li>Approaches new families referred to the program to ask if they'd like to join or be mentored. Follows up until family accepts, declines or there is no response.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Enters data into the database for recruitment and encounters.</li> </ul>	
	• Contacts mentors and families as their 12 week mark is reached to evaluate the program, graduate them, or re-enroll if needed.	
	<ul> <li>Shadow and observe new mentors during their first face-to-face encounter and sign off on their competencies.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Assists in planning and leading content for several sections in new mentor trainings.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Assists in planning and leading debriefing sessions.</li> </ul>	

- Serves on the PAIR Mentor Steering Council.
- Speaks on behalf of the program when appropriate to a variety of audiences, internal and external.
- Assists in the recruitment process by calling and conducting the initial screening of PAIR mentor candidates.
- Respects and protects the confidentiality of patients, family members and employees at all times and in all circumstances.
- Promotes patient and family centered care in clinical, educational and research programs within St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.
