The **REACH** initiative is committed to providing hospice nurses in the state of Tennessee with access to expert pediatric-specific training and support to empower you in provision of high quality, compassionate care to children and families. Through our partnership with **Project ECHO**[™], we will provide evidence-based knowledge, resources, peer support and community for hospice nurses across our state.

Virtual gatherings will be offered monthly via Zoom on the third Thursday of the month. Each session will be 90 minutes long and include a brief didactic presentation followed by a case-based discussion, concluding with a short mindfulness activity. Presentation topics will be selected based on feedback from regional hospice nurses, and sessions will be led by pediatric palliative care and hospice experts.

- Difficult communication
- Grief and bereavement
